DEET 50% spray is a high strength insect repellent for protection against mosquitos and other biting and stinging insects.

Protection from insect bites on exposed skin is critical to protect against tropical diseases including Malaria, Dengue Fever and West Nile Virus. PelGar's DEET 50% Spray contains a dual action formula which combines natural pyrethrins with DEET to provide a high level of protection against biting insects in all environments.

DEET has long been considered the most effective mosquito repellent. Originally formulated in the USA for military troops, DEET (diethyltoluamide) is recognised globally as a powerful insect repellent which blocks insect receptors so they cannot sense our sweat, body odours and CO2 emissions.

Each application will last for up to 8 hours. Re-application may be required in areas with high temperature and humidity.



Why use DEET 50% spray?

- Easily applied to skin for up to 8 hour protection
- Can be used on children over 2 months old
- DEET blocks the insect receptors to provide repellence
- Pyrethrins provide fast knockdown of insects to prohibit bites
- Piperonyl butoxide (PBO) inhibits insect metabolic resistance to increase efficacy

Technical Information

DEET 50% Personal Insect Repellent Spray will repel insects such as mosquitoes, midges (including the Scottish midge), sandflies, horseflies, cleggs, ticks, wasps, hornets, moths, houseflies, cluster flies, fruit flies, fleas, bedbugs and ants.

Application

When applying directly on to skin, use sufficient quantities to cover exposed areas. Rub in well. To put repellent on face and neck, dispense a small amount on to your palm and rub on. Avoid contact with sunburnt or damaged skin. Keep the repellent away from eyes and mouth.

There is no need to apply the repellent frequently. However, you will need to use repellent more often in areas of high humidity or when you perspire a great deal. You should reapply repellent after swimming or showering.

Important:

Please read all warnings and safety precautions before use. Avoid contact with synthetic substances and plastics, eg spectacle frames and luggage.

Precautions

Keep out of the reach of children.

If in eyes: rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.
